


Rachel Zimmerman

MOVING TIPS:

WHAT TO DO, AND WHEN TO DO IT

Planning on moving soon? It's a popular season for it. Combine the desire for new digs with the need to pack up all your stuff, stir in some cleaning, fold in some unexpected delays, add up all the costs, and you may start to wonder if you should stay put.

Moving can be a pain in the ... wallet, particularly if you wait until the last minute to start the process. So what's the key to success? Start planning early. Begin by evaluating your finances. Are you going to "do it yourself," or can you afford the help of professional movers? What should you do, when?

One month before the move:

- Hold a garage sale and donate items to local charities.
- Fill out address change forms.
- Notify current--and new--utilities.
- Inventory your belongings.
- Finalize arrangements with the moving company, or reserve a rental truck.

One to two weeks before the move:

- If you're moving a substantial distance, collect valuables from your safe deposit box.
- Contact your insurance agent about coverage during the move.
- Use up food so there's less to pack

On moving day, and within a few weeks of your move:

- Carry important documents/valuables with you.
- Keep all receipts--some are tax-deductible.
- Renew your driver's license & auto registration.
- Find local hospitals, police, schools, and veterinarian.
- Update your will to reflect the new address.
- Shop around for new insurance policies.
