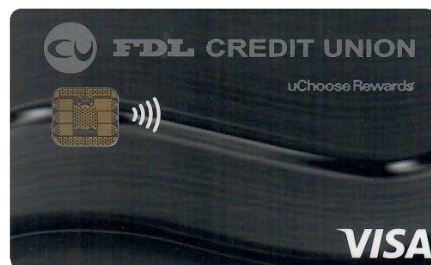

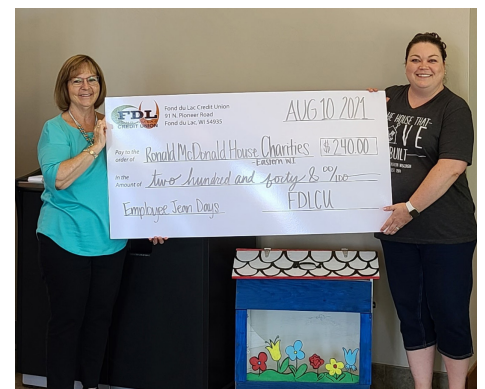

## 7 MONEY HABITS THAT CAN BOOST YOUR CREDIT SCORE

**(1) Pay bills early.** Timely monthly payments are the best way to boost your score. **(2) Multiple payments.** Make more than one monthly payment toward your credit card bill. **(3) Sign up for alerts.** Sign up for credit card balance and payment due date alerts so you never miss a payment. **(4) Max out monthly payments.** Every dollar counts. Pay whatever you can reasonably afford beyond the minimum. **(5) Sign up for Experian Boost.** Make your monthly utility bills count toward your credit score when you sign up. **(6) Check your credit report.** Look for fraudulent charges and dispute anything that is suspicious. **(7) Don't open new cards.** Keep the ones you have open, but don't start a new credit line when trying to improve your score.
