When it comes to buying a new car, deciding which one you want is not your only decision. As you finalize your financing, you're presented with additional coverage or warranty options - GAP Coverage, Mechanical Repair Coverage, Debt Protection options. What are they, and should you consider them?

### GAP COVERAGE

Additional insurance that covers your vehicle's value between the amount you owe, and the amount the vehicle is worth.

### MECHANICAL REPAIR COVERAGE

Coverage that can help with repair costs for your vehicle due to mechanical defects.

### DEBT PROTECTION

Protection that helps with payments due to circumstances like disability, involuntary unemployment, or passing away.

## Real or Fake?

We've said it before, and were going to say it again - STAY INFORMED & BE AWARE. Scammers are still at it, and they don't appear to be slowing down. Which ones are we seeing in our area?

- Romance - scammers create fake profiles on dating sites and apps or contact you through social media. They try to strike up a relationship with you to build trust, then make up a story and ask for money.
- Phishing - an online scam that targets consumers by sending them an e-mail that appears to be from a well-known source, and asking them for personal identifying info.
- IRA - victim is instructed to open an IRA account, with a fraudulent check, and then withdraw the funds right away.
